Job purpose:

To carry out electrical inspection & testing, electrical reactive and planned maintenance works. Work activity will depend on location, but will normally fall into the categories of tenanted & void properties, general repair and maintenance, prior to paint or modernizations.

- To be fully conversant with all aspects of electrical installation works of both 230v and 400v.
- 4 Ensure compliance with the IEE Wiring Regulations at all times, and that the appropriate materials used.
- 5 To undertake testing of all portable and fixed electrical equipment (PAT Testing).
- To liaise with customers to arrange appointments, access arrangements, discuss works etc.
- 7 Carry out and complete all works to high quality and in a competent manner and with the property being left in a clean and tidy condition.
- 8 To work with, and provide information relating to technical matters, to any group as directed by the Supervisor.
- 9 To liaise with other staff, Surveyors and Sub-contractors as necessary to ensure the timely completion of works within agreed operational targets.
- Ensure accurate and timely completion of all paperwork including job tickets and timesheets and ensure this is passed to your Supervisor within agreed timescales.
- To accept progress and complete accurately all works allocated via the mobile working device (PDA's).
- 12 Ensure that any required qualifications for your position remain valid and to ensure that any necessary training is arranged and undertaken within the specified timescales.
- 13 To attend meetings, training sessions and conferences as required.
- 14 To participate in the companies out of hour's emergency service.
- To act at all times in accordance with the companies rules, policies, procedures and financial regulations.
